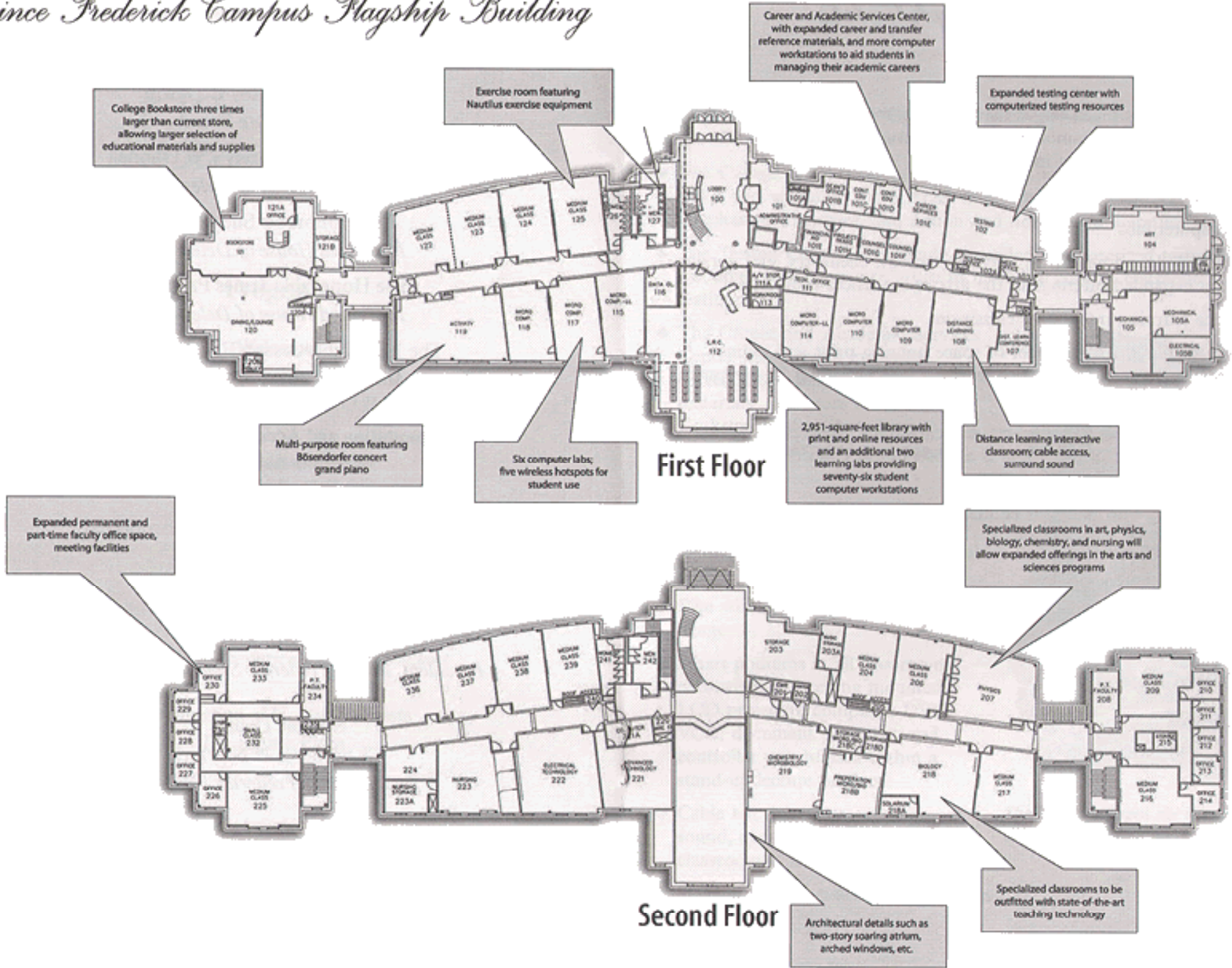

Facility Highlights

Space

The new building is much larger than the Broomes Island Road facility, and can effectively accommodate a growing student population. The 56,000-square-foot building includes:

- ◆ Twenty-three classrooms
- ◆ Six computer labs
- ◆ Specialized classrooms in art, physics, biology, chemistry, and nursing to allow expanded offerings in the arts and sciences programs
- ◆ Distance learning interactive classroom
- ◆ Library with 2,951 square feet of space housing print and online resources and an additional two learning labs providing 76 computer workstations
- ◆ Multi-purpose room for concerts, student events, lectures, and community events; in this room is a Bösendorfer concert grand piano for student and community events
- ◆ Exercise room with Nautilus equipment
- ◆ Student lounge
- ◆ Student government office
- ◆ Permanent faculty office space
- ◆ Part-time faculty meeting space
- ◆ Conference room

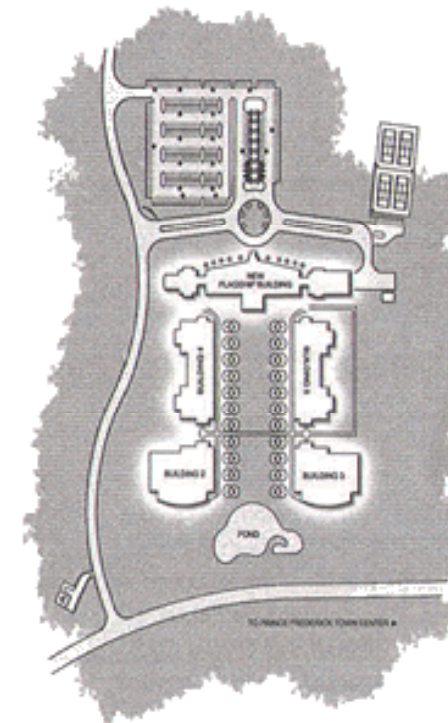
Services

The spacious campus will allow CSM to better serve students in several areas. For example:

- ◆ The College Store is approximately three times larger than the existing space and will allow for a larger selection of educational materials, merchandise, supplies, and fiction and non-fiction literature.
- ◆ The Testing Center will include expanded computerized testing resources and a separate office to minimize student distraction while testing.
- ◆ The Career and Academic Services Center will provide expanded career and transfer reference materials, and more computer workstations to aid students in managing their academic careers.

Technology

- ◆ Three network systems: two virtual networks and a wireless network
- ◆ Five wireless hotspots for Internet usage
- ◆ Smart podiums in all classrooms, consisting of a ceiling mounted LCD projector, computer, DVD/VCR, document projector, and controller unit housed within a stand-up lecture podium
- ◆ Cable television access, surround sound, and telephone access in all classrooms
- ◆ State-of-the-art digital phone system



The 75-acre campus site allows for the construction of four more buildings.
